## II. THE SERVANT GETS ALL THE GLORY 49:5-7

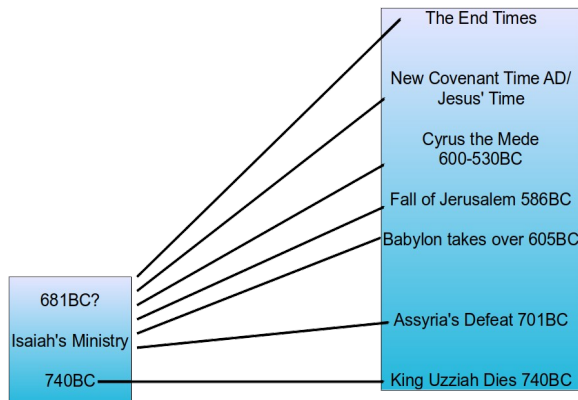
God's original promise to Abram:

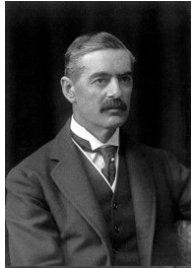

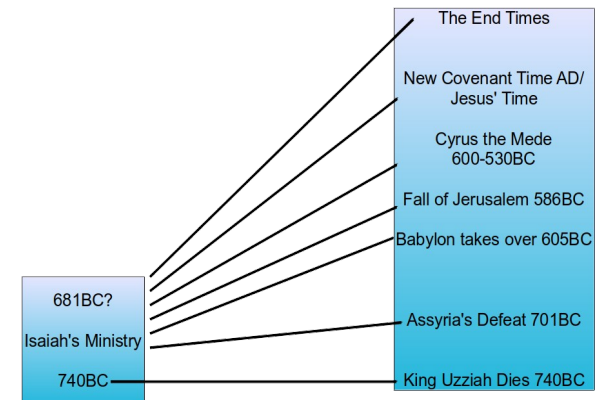
