

JOHN 5:19-30 – JUDGE JESUS? ESV

INTRODUCTION 5:1-6:4

- 5:18 *This was why the Jews were seeking all the more to kill [Jesus], because not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God his own Father, making himself equal with God.*

a) 5:1-18 is the case against Jesus, brought by the Jewish leaders;

b) 5:19-6:4 is Jesus' (rare) defence of himself.

As Jesus now makes his legal defence, we see that the Jews were badly mistaken about who was in the dock for **III** reasons:-

I. JESUS WORKS HAND-IN-GLOVE WITH THE FATHER 19-23

II. JESUS WILL RESURRECT EVERYBODY 21,25-29

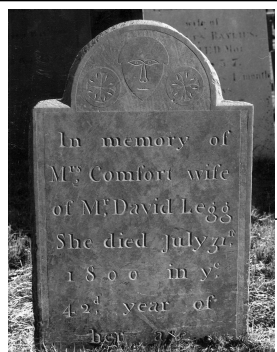
III. JESUS WILL JUDGE JUSTLY 27,30

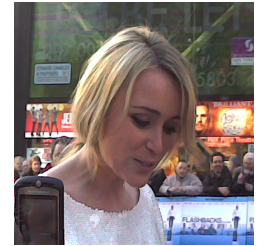
