INTRODUCTION

Psalm 76 traditionally has the same context as Psalm 75, i.e. Sennacherib besieging Jerusalem in 701BC.

I. IS THIS GOD YOUR GOD? 76:1-6

- 1 *In Judah* God is known; his name is great *in Israel*.
- 2 ... *in Salem*, ... *in Zion*.
- 3 *There* he broke the flashing arrows, the shield, the sword, and the weapons of war.
- *Inscription: This [song] is about the Assyrian.*

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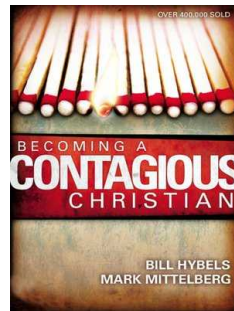
II. RESPONDING TO YOUR GOD 76:7-11, 2 KINGS 18-19

III. IS YOUR FEAR OF GOD CONTAGIOUS? 76:1,12

- 76:1 *In Judah* God is known; ...
- 76:12 ... who cuts off the spirit of princes, who is to be feared by the kings of the earth.
- *Matthew 10:28 And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell.*

Fear God most, so that Non-Christians will take note and catch your fear.



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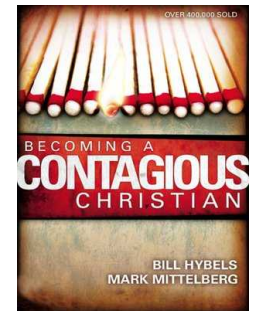
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
