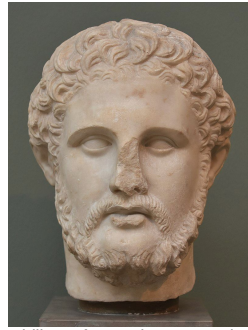


PSALM 65 ENCOURAGEMENT TO PERSEVERE

[πεδία=fields LXX] overflow with abundance. *ESV*

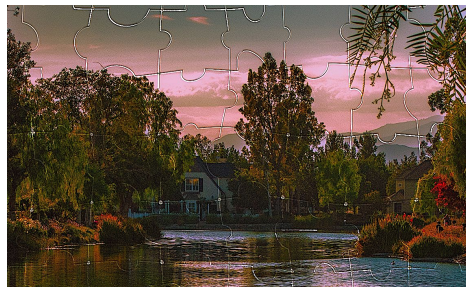

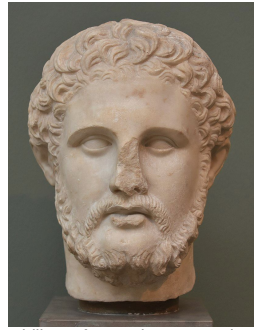

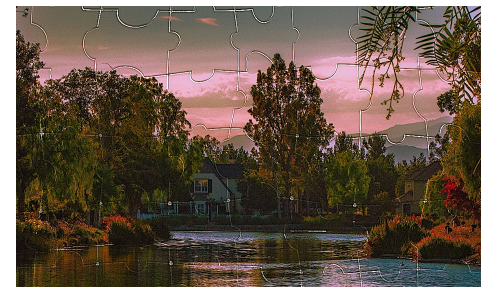
