- *Psalm 55:23e But I am trusting in you [LORD].* DWL

I. FIND CONFIDENCE IN GOD 2-14

- *2 Samuel 12:10 [Nathan:] Now therefore the sword shall never depart from your house, because you have despised me and have taken the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be your wife.' ¹¹ Thus says the LORD, 'Behold, I will raise up evil against you out of your own house ...* ESV

a) It is all his own fault (2 Sam 12).

b) It is not Philistines etc. but his *friend* Ahithophel.

- *2 Samuel 17:23 When Ahithophel saw that his counsel was not [being] followed, he saddled his donkey and went off home to his own city. He set his house in order and hanged himself, ...* ESV

- *Hebrews 4:16 Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.* ESV

- *Hebrews 5:2 He can deal gently with the ignorant and wayward, since he himself is beset with weakness.* ESV



II. FIND CLARITY 15-21

- *Colossians 1:9 ... we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, ...* ESV

III. THROW AWAY YOUR BURDEN 22-23
